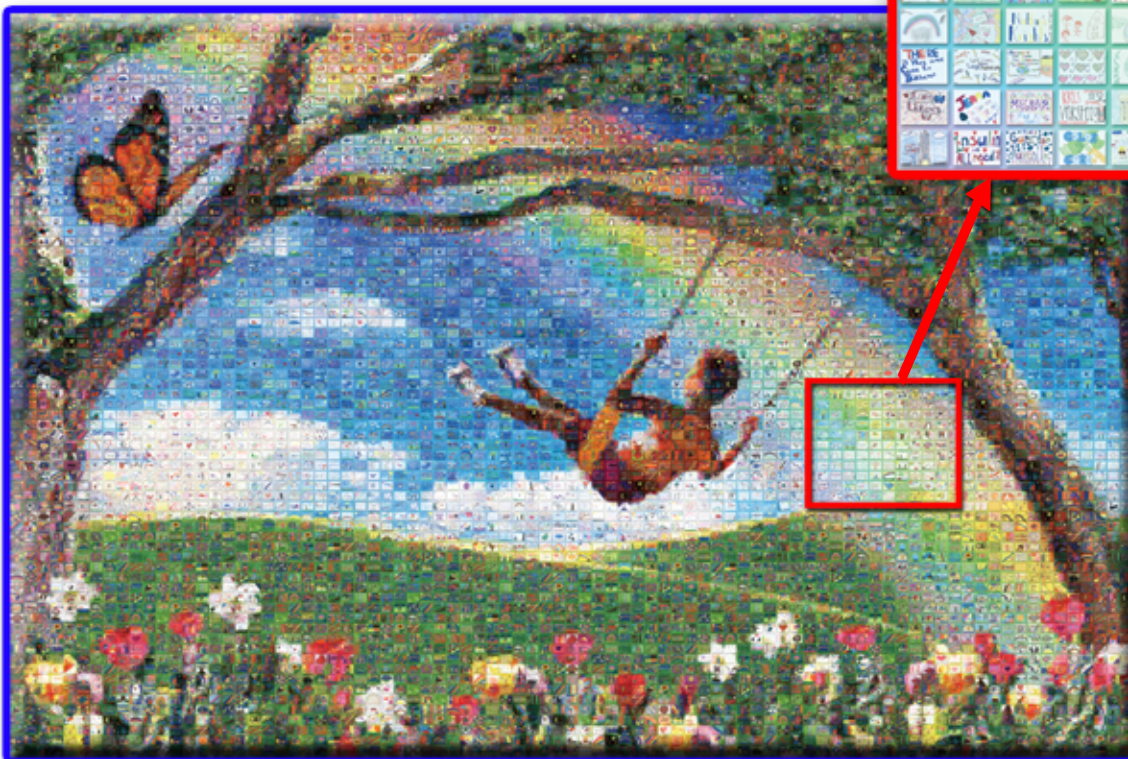
We need your help to create the “big picture”!
